

8.45.CMS---DISTRICT PURCHASED CLOTHING POLICY

The Cutter Morning Star School Board authorized the superintendent to purchase clothing for district employees when the purchase is related to a school purpose. The Board recognizes the benefit of having district employees wearing similar clothing in order that the employees are easily recognized. Examples of events are as follows, but not limited to the below list.

Parent-Teacher Conference
Field Trips
School Open house

As a term and condition of employment, district employees shall be required to wear the school purchased clothing to the school events when requested by the district administration. Failure for an employee to wear the clothing when requested may result in disciplinary action.

As the value of clothing after being worn becomes de minimus, the Board authorizes that district employees need not return clothing purchased in accordance with this policy unless otherwise directed by the superintendent.
